Abstract	The collection documents the career of Albert Gordon Hill, who was professor of physics at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) from 1947 to 1955. Hill also held administrative positions as the director of several research laboratories at MIT. The collection contains records of his tenure as vice president for research at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, 1970-1975, and includes material documenting the divestment of the Instrumentation Laboratory at MIT, which became the Charles Stark Draper Laboratory, Inc. in 1973.

Biography

Albert Gordon Hill, BS, 1930, MS 1934, Washington University; PhD in physics, 1937, University of Rochester, was professor of physics at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT). He also held administrative positions as the director of several research laboratories at MIT, and was chairman of the Board of Directors, Charles Stark Draper Laboratory, Inc., 1973-1982. At MIT, Hill chaired the committee that proposed and organized the Office for Minority Education.

Scope and Contents of the Collection

As Vice President for Research at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, 1970-1975, Albert Hill had overall responsibility for laboratories conducting sponsored research as well as the off campus

Lincoln Laboratory. The collection documents the divestment of the Instrumentation Laboratory which transitioned to an independent Charles Stark Draper Laboratory in 1973. Correspondence, memoranda, and reports document his administrative involvement in the Energy Laboratory, the Research Laboratory of Electronics, the Instrumentation Laboratory, Lincoln Laboratory, the Laboratory for Nuclear Science, and the Plasma Fusion Center.

The collection also documents Hill's early career as a staff member of the war time Radiation Laboratory, and his teaching and research activities at MIT in the Department of Physics.

Albert Hill's involvement with government security and military organizations such as the North Atlantic Treaty Organization, the Institute for Defense Analyses, the National Security Agency, and the United States Air Force are documented in this collection. Also included is correspondence with professional organizations including the American Institute of Electrical Engineers, the American Institute of Physics, and the American Physical Society. Finally, correspondence and reports document Hill's involvement with outside corporations including Bowmar Instrumentation Corporation, General Atronics, Charles Stark Draper Laboratory, General Dynamics, and International Business Machines.
